**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information  
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspect(s)**

**Lansdowne, PA – January 30, 2014** – The Lansdowne Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy robbery that occurred at Pepper’s Pharmacy located at 197 East Plumstead Avenue in Lansdowne.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL<sup>®</sup>, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. **Robbery Details for Public Announcement:**

The Lansdowne Police Department and Crime Stoppers are investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at Pepper’s Pharmacy, located at 197 East Plumstead Avenue in Lansdowne. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

- **Date/Time:** Thursday, January 16, 2014, approximately 6:38pm
- **Location:** Pepper’s Pharmacy, 197 East Plumstead Avenue, Lansdowne, PA
- **Description of Events:** Suspect entered through the front door, walked into the pharmacy area, displayed a black handgun and demanded controlled substances. He fled out the front door after taking an undetermined amount of medicine and cash from the register.
- **Suspect Description:** Suspect is described as a black male in his early twenties, approximately 5’9” tall with brown eyes and black hair. He wore a blue Penn State sweatshirt and a black knit hat. His face was covered except for his eyes.
