

**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect**

Cornelia, Georgia – September 29, 2014 – The Cornelia Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for one pharmacy burglary that occurred at Tim’s Pharmacy located at 130 Magnolia Lane, Cornelia, Georgia.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Further information is available to authorized personnel at www.RxPATROL.org.

Burglary Details for Public Announcement:

The Cornelia Police Department is investigating one pharmacy burglary. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

Burglary #1 Details

- **Date/Time:** Sunday, August 10, 2014, approximately 0600am
- **Location:** Tim’s Pharmacy, 130 Magnolia Lane, Cornelia, Georgia
- **Description of Events:** The suspect’s were familiar with the layout of Tim’s Pharmacy and went directly to the locations of the narcotics; which had been moved to different locations within the prior week. In making entry into the pharmacy through the front door the suspects were able to only damage the front door slightly and the pharmacy area sustained no damage except for the Schedule II closet door was pried open. The suspects used what appears to be a “hooligan” tool to make entry on the front double glass doors, committed the theft and exited the building before law enforcement arrived. A White Chrysler 300 was seen at the burglary site.
- **Suspect Description:** Two White males, age 30-35, 5’10”, 170 lbs. The video does not show any special descriptive appearance.
