

**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspects**

Omaha, NE – May 31, 2014 – The Omaha Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspects believed to be responsible for a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the Walgreens Pharmacy located at 13155 W. Center Road in Omaha, Nebraska.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Further information is available to authorized personnel at www.RxPATROL.org.

“It’s important for people to know that all information that we get is kept completely confidential. Callers never have to give their names or appear in court. The *Crime Stoppers* tip line does not use any tape recording or caller ID devices,” said *Crime Stoppers* coordinator, James Shade.

Robbery Details for Public Announcement:

The Omaha Police Department and Crime Stoppers are investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the Walgreens Pharmacy, located at 13155 W. Center Road in Omaha, Nebraska. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

- **Date/Time:** Saturday, May 31, 2014, approximately 7:47pm
- **Location:** Walgreens Pharmacy, located at 13155 W. Center Road in Omaha, Nebraska
- **Description of Events:** Omaha Police officers received a radio call to the above listed Walgreens for a report of a robbery. Upon arrival officers learned a white male suspect had entered the store, proceeded to the pharmacy and after displaying a handgun tucked into his pants, demanded pills from the employee. Suspect was given the items he demanded. It is believed that the suspect fled in a maroon Chevy pickup driven by a second male party.
- **Suspect Description:** White male believed to have fled in a maroon Chevy pickup driven by another male party.
